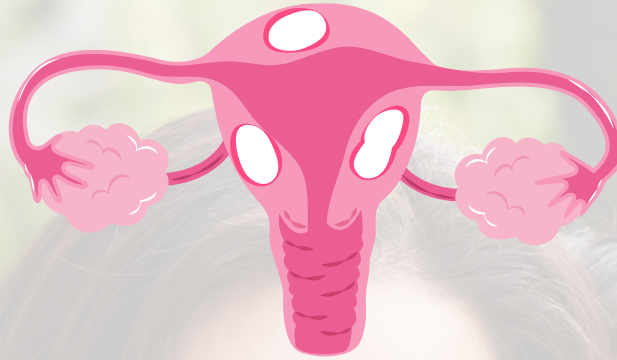
# WHAT ARE UTERINE FIBROIDS?

Uterine fibroids are the most common tumors found in the female reproductive system. Forming on or around the uterus, these fibroids are benign (non-cancerous) and are usually not dangerous to a woman's health. They can, however, cause painful and/or disruptive symptoms.



## SYMPTOMS OF UTERINE FIBROIDS

- ✓ Unpredictable Cycles
- ✓ Heavy Menstrual Bleeding

- ✓ Pelvic Pain or Pressure

## UTERINE FIBROID EMBOLIZATION (UFE)

There are many options to treat uterine fibroids, but only interventional radiologists perform UFE. Through a tiny incision on the groin, an interventional radiologist inserts a catheter that delivers particles to block the small blood vessels that feed each uterine fibroid, causing them to shrink and disappear.

UFE is a safe, effective, and non-surgical alternative to hysterectomy that features a **patient satisfaction rate of over 90%!**

# WHAT IS PELVIC CONGESTION SYNDROME?

Pelvic Congestion Syndrome is a chronic medical condition in women caused by varicose veins in the lower abdomen. The condition causes chronic pain, often manifesting as a constant dull ache which can be aggravated by standing. Early treatment options include pain medication, alternative therapies (such as acupuncture), and suppression of ovarian function.

Surgery can be performed using non-invasive transcatheter techniques to eliminate the varicose veins. **Up to 80% of women obtain relief using this method.**
